

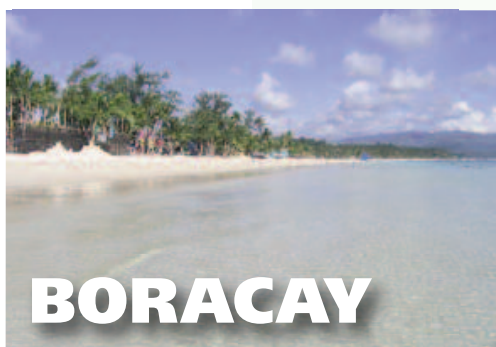
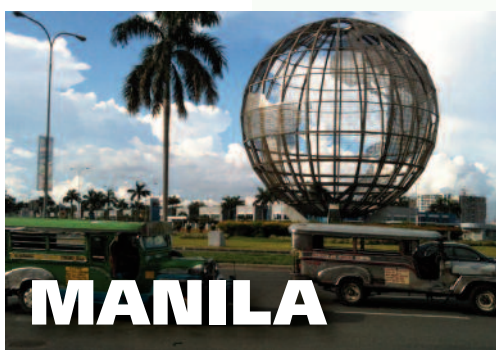

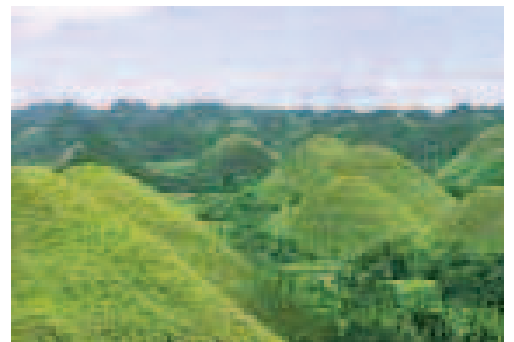

Sabang, Puerto Princesa

Several of Palawan's most beautiful beaches are to be found north of Puerto Princesa.

The beaches are separated by the Sabang River which runs through mangroves. Sabang is situated close to the entrance to St Paul's Underground River. The area is rich with wildlife.



Underground River

Awarded World Heritage Site status in 1999, St Paul's Underground River is a national park running for 5 miles through a limestone cave before opening out into a lagoon.

This area is extremely active with wildlife, including Philippine macaques, monitor lizards and the highly endangered, flightless, tabon bird.
