Day 1 - Arrive Manila. Transfer to Hotel. Overnight in Manila

---

Day 2 - Transfer to Airport for Flight to Bohol

Arrive Tagbilaran Airport. Transfer to Resort

---

Day 3 - Bohol Country Side Tour inclusive of lunch. Visit to 6 major attractions:

Blood Compact, a marker which commemorates the spot where Datu Sikatuna, a native chieftain forged a blood compact with Don Miguel Lopez de Legazpi representing the king of Spain for the purpose of fostering friendly relations between the two countries; considered as the first treaty of friendship between the brown and white races

Centuries-old Baclayon church and museum

Loboc - Bilar Man-made forest

Chocolate Hills, the province's signature attraction

Loboc River cruise, a fascinating boat ride along palm-fringed banks with lunch

Philippine tarsiers, considered the smallest living primate, whose existence dates back to more than 45 million years ago

Day 4 - Panglao Island Half-Day Tour. Places to visit include Bohol Bee Farm, Hinagdanan Cave, Dauis Church, Bohol Coco Farm, Nova Sea Shell Museum & Alona White Sandy Beach

---

Day 5 - Whale and Dolphin Spotting Balicasag Island inclusive of lunch

Whale and dolphin-watching has become a popular ecotourism activity in the area where sightings have become almost certain.



### Bohol

*A wonderful island, Bohol has beautiful tropical beaches, coral reefs, and the famously distinctive Chocolate Hills.*

*Take a cruise on the Loboc river, enjoy scuba-diving, or go dolphin and whale-watching. See the Philippines tarsier - the world's smallest primate. Relax on the beautiful beaches of Panglao Island.*

### Panglao Island, Bohol

*Panglao Island is connected to Bohol by bridge, and is a great place to explore in itself. It has sandy beaches and a variety of accommodation, from eco-friendly to luxury resorts.*

*The Coconut Farm, Tarsier Botanika with its wildlife sanctuary & Art Collection, and Bee Farm are all worth visiting.*

Dolphin species abundant in the area are bottlenose, spinner, and spotted while 13 species of cetaceans are found including the melon-headed and baby sperm whales.

The tour includes a visit to an uninhabited yet beautiful white sandy islet with the opportunity for swimming.

The more curious who love to explore underwater marine life may opt to go snorkeling.

Day 6 - Transfer to Port. Fast Ferry to Cebu. Arrive Cebu Port. Start of Cebu City Sightseeing Tour.

Tour highlights: Historical and cultural landmarks in Cebu City such as Magellan's Cross, Fort San Pedro, Basilica Minore del Sto, Niño and Taoist Temple in the Beverly Hills Subdivision, as well as souvenir shops. After the tour, transfer to Hotel.

Day 7 - Free Day to Relax in your Resort

Day 8 - Cebu South Countryside Tour.

Day 9 - Transfer to Airport for Flight to Manila.

Day 10 - Transfer to Airport for Flight Home
